




The project

The presence of a monster in Loch Ness dates back to Antiquity: engravings on stone made by the Picts, who at that time lived in the region, represent a mysterious beast endowed with fins.

The first written trace dates back to 565 A.D. in a biography of the Irish abbot Saint Colomba, the evangelist of Scotland in the 6th century who explained having ordered the monster to vanish. According to the Loch Ness Centre, more than 1100 official sightings of Nessie have been reported up until now.





Every technique possible has been used to study the 56 km², 272 m deep loch. DNA sampling of the water by geneticist Neil Gemmell thermal scanners, drones, infrared cameras, hydrophones... Although nothing unusual has ever been discovered, the mystery of the legend persists. This is all it took to heighten the curiosity of our adventurer. The Nessie project was born.

From Lake Leman to Loch Ness by bike followed by My Way in convoy, an eco way to travel which will enable as many people as possible to discover My Way on the road. The launch will take place at Fort Augustus, and we will start exploring the 39 km long loch at the beginning of July 2024. My night and day observation of Nessie's domain, close to Urquhart Castle over a period of several weeks, in total isolation, will be a first.

The Budget

My personal contribution is my pedal boat My Way

For this adventure to succeed we need:

1 Racing bike + equipment (shoes, cycling shorts)	3000 £
Daily life on board (clothes, sleeping bag, mattress)	1000 £
Renovation of My Way (camouflage)	2000 £
Round trip for two people Lake Leman-Loch Ness	2000 £
4000 kms (fuel, accommodation, food)	
Freeze-dried food for a period of several weeks	1500 £
Observation (video cameras, camera, echo sounder, drone)	3500 £
Management of My Way in Scotland (the launch of the boat)	1000 £
In total (possibility of donations of equipment) 1400	oo £

My Way and its "camouflage" look following in the footsteps of Nessie will be the unmissable attraction for the summer of 2024.






